Score notes from the rehearsal on 23rd September

Mendelssohn: Elijah. We are using the 1991 (red and white) Novello edition. If you have an older edition, there may be some small changes to note. Page numbers are the same.

Daniel did some warm-up exercises singing legato phrases. We sang notes of the scale as 1,121,12321, etc but in place of each 3 and 5 (or other numbers chosen by him) we had to clap once! We also sang the alphabet, forwards and backwards. This might benefit from practice.... Daniel encouraged us to hold copies up so that we could see him – at least for facial expressions! We need to stop when he raises his hand.

We rehearsed all the main choruses in part 2 except No 41. Just the chorus part in no 35 P169.
